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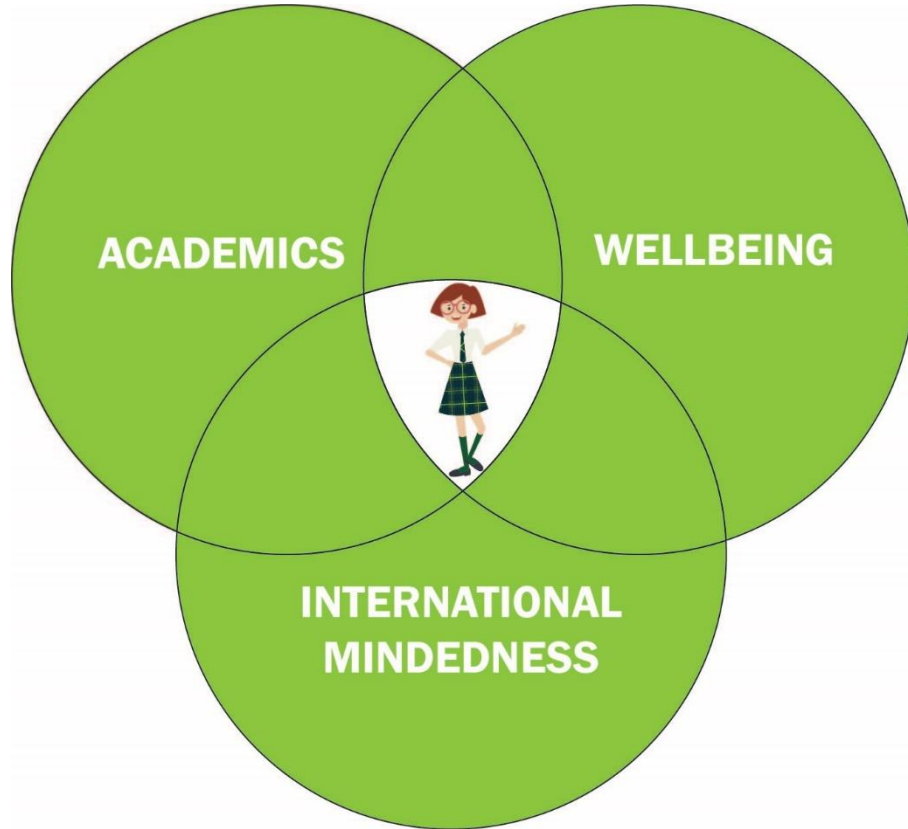

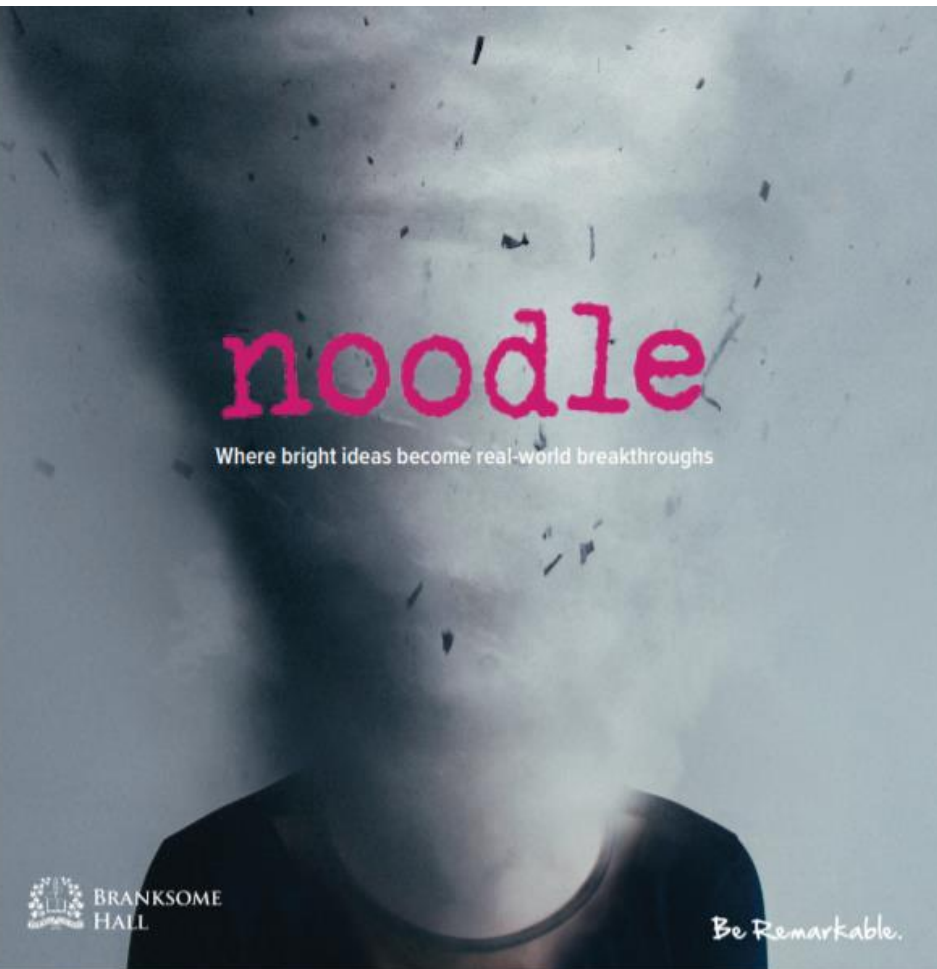

Noodle nurtures, identifies then brings our students' most inventive ideas to life with the support of faculty, expert advisors and entrepreneurs.

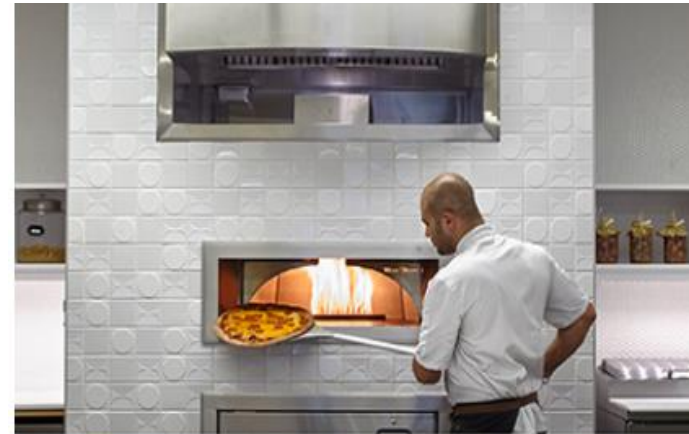
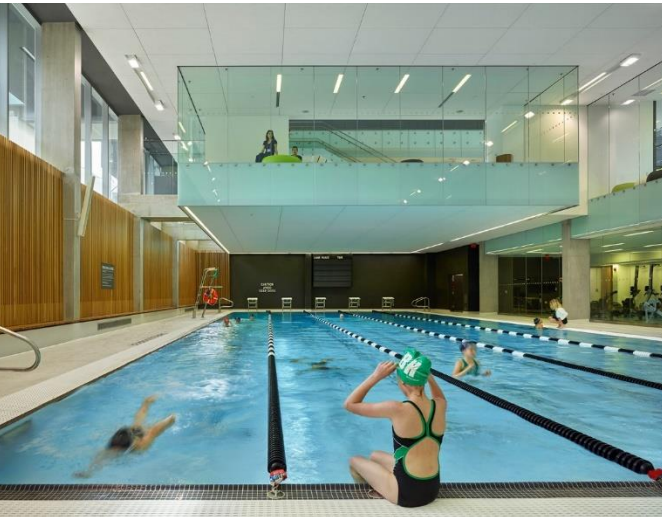

Weekend Programming

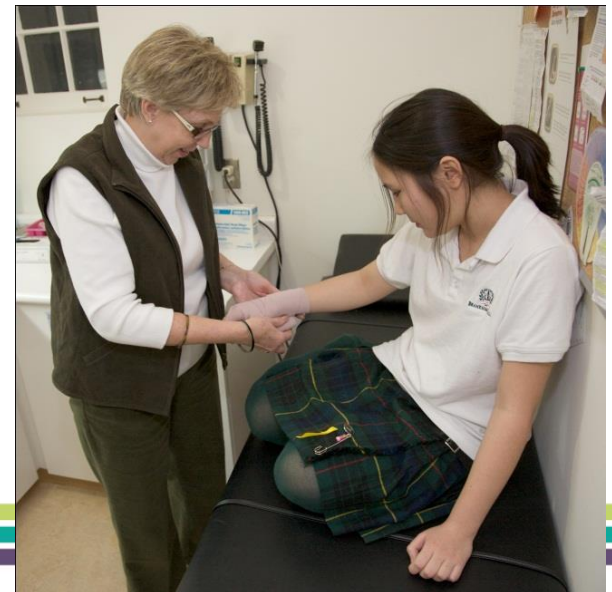
Branksome Hall's boarding program remains open on all long weekends. Students are only required to leave campus for the December Break (2 weeks), the March Break (2 weeks) and Summer
